### Semester Exams / End of the Semester:

- Semester Exams will begin on Tuesday, December 11th and will end on Wednesday, December 19th.
- The end of the 3rd Six-Weeks is on Friday, December 21st.
- The new semester begins on Wednesday, January 9th.
- On January 9th, students will receive their second semester schedule and will run a homeroom / blue day schedule.

### Toys for Tots (Toy Drive):

- BHI will be collecting new toys beginning on Monday, December 3rd until Monday, December 17th. The toys collected will be given to children in the community that would not otherwise receive toys for the Holidays.
- You may bring a toy or \$1.00 and it can remove a day of main detention.
- The goal for the Toy Drive is to collect 250 toys. The grade level that brings the most toys will receive a non-standardized dress day for Wednesday, December 19th.

### December 20th and December 21st
